

# STORYTIME THEATRE

## **Grades K-1 Wednesdays 5:15-6:15pm in Studio C**

These 8-week workshops are offered throughout the season. Each session introduces new material and is designed for a student to register for 1 or more sessions as desired. They introduce students to the basic elements of acting, using classic fairy tales and children's stories as inspiration to develop body awareness, self-confidence, and respect for others. Students will participate in interactive exercises and theatre-based games, using imagination, props, and toys to tell stories as a way of self-expression. *Students will perform a short play, scene, or skit on the last day of each workshop session based on the curriculum covered during the session.*



### **SESSION 1 Meets September 14<sup>th</sup>-November 2<sup>nd</sup> CLUB MAKE BELIEVE**

Have you ever wanted to go to a make believe place like Neverland, Wonderland, or Narnia? Through the use of visual aids, music, and other media, we will use our imaginations to create worlds of wonder. Focus will be on learning basic acting techniques and developing aesthetic awareness.

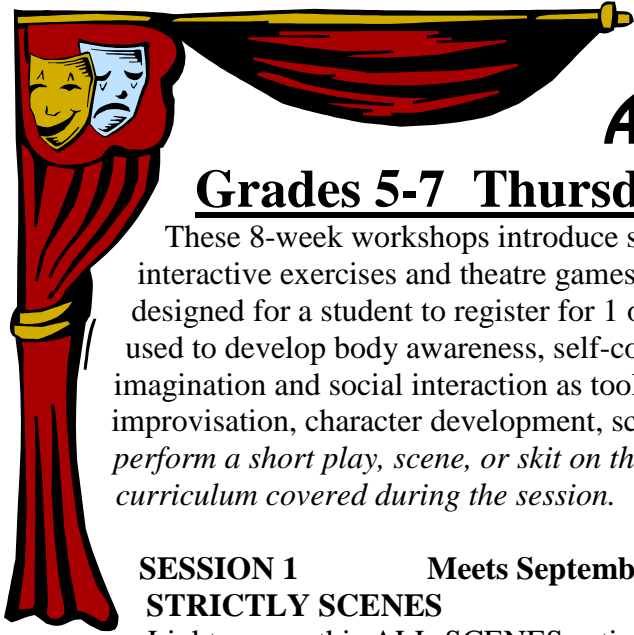
### **SESSION 3 Meets January 25<sup>th</sup>-March 14<sup>th</sup> STRICTLY SCENES**
